

8 Moedim - the Lord's Feasts

Parshat Emor ~ Leviticus 23:1 - 24:23

- 1] **Shabbat [Sabbath] the seventh day** Friday sunset until Saturday sunset
Genesis 2:1-3, Leviticus 23:3, Numbers 28:9, Ezekiel 45:17
- 2] **Pesach [Passover] Nisan 15 • [April 6]** Yeshua crucified
Leviticus 23:5, Numbers 28:16, 1 Corinthians 5:7-8, 2 Corinthians 5:21
We have salvation not by our works, but by the atoning sacrifice of Yeshua. This directs us to good works in our lives, by the fruits of the Holy Spirit. James 2:21-26
 - a. Don't sin - Paul didn't know what sin was without Torah. Rom. 7:7, 1 John 1:3-4
 - b. Be righteous and holy. Ephesians 4:24
- 3] **Chag Hamotzi [Unleavened Bread] Nisan 16-22 • [April 7-13]** Yeshua buried
Begin counting the Omer on Nisan 16 for 50 days, until Shavu'ot on Sivan 6 [May 26]
Leviticus 23:6, Numbers 28:17-25, Luke 23:5
- 4] **Yom Habikkurim [First Fruits] Nisan 16 • [April 7]** Yeshua raised
Leviticus 23:10-11, Numbers 28:26-31, Luke:24:6, I Corinthians 15:20
- 5] **Shavu'ot [Feast of Weeks|Pentecost] Sivan 6-7 • [May 26-27]** Ruach ha Kodesh sent
Leviticus 23:17-21, Numbers 28:26-31, Acts 2:4
- 6] **Yom Teru'ah [Trumpets] Tishrei 1-2 • [Sep. 16-17]** to be fulfilled: Coming of Moshiach
Also called **Rosh HaShanah**/Head of the Year | Leviticus 23:24-25, Numbers 29:1-6,
Matthew 24:31, I Thessalonians 4:16, 1 Corinthians 15:52, Revelation 11:15
- 7] **Yom ha Kippurim [Atonement] Tishrei 10 • [Sep. 25]** to be fulfilled: White Throne judgment
Previous to Yom Kippur, we conclude 40 days of repentance [started on Av 30] by observing '10 Days of Awe' known as 'Aseret Yemei Teshuva'. This is a time of solemn repentance from when the books are 'opened' on Rosh HaShanah, until books are 'closed' on Yom Kippur.

- 8] **Sukkot [Tabernacles] Tishrei 15-21 • [Sep. 30-Oct. 6]** to be fulfilled: Wedding Feast
Leviticus 23:34, Numbers 29:12-38, Ezekiel 45:25, Zechariah 14:16-19, Revelation 7:9, 21:3

3 Spring Feasts [around March/April]
Shavu'ot marks beginning of summer harvest [early June]
3 Fall Feasts [around September/October]
